Continuing Beginners

- For people and dogs who have already participated in Beginners Agility
- There is room for every handler and dog – no need to worry about full classes, no need to worry about how often you can participate or whether you want to compete. Agility is for all teams who want to have fun and learn some new skills.
- 7 -10 dogs at practices.
- The regular fee for teams who participate in May and June, is \$140.00
- If you think that you will only participate sporadically, the fee is \$75 for up to any 6 lessons throughout May and June.
- If you have 2 dogs, and at least one is in the CB or Intermediate group, your 2nd dog costs 1/2 of the full fee.
- April 29 start date.
- There are 2 groups with different practice times. Each practice is approx. 1 hour. You choose your group.
- If you work non-traditional hours or are retired, let Gay know and maybe we can organize a daytime group.
- We can also work with you so that you can train some skills if you come to the field on your own.
